MENTOR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

As a mentor you will provide support to a formerly incarcerated woman through a one-on-one relationship which will increase her empowerment and self-esteem! You will assist your mentee by helping her set and achieve personal goals, model and teach life skills such as communication, budgeting, time management, etc. You will provide referrals to relevant community resources and much more!

MENTOR COMMITMENTS

By becoming a mentor you are committing to one year of volunteering, which includes 10 hours of mentor training, weekly in-person meetings the first three months, and regular in-person and phone meetings the remainder of year.

Mentors are required to attend monthly ongoing trainings and match events, agree to adhere to YWCA Labyrinth policies and procedures and support the mission of YWCA.

Personal or professional experience in the following areas is helpful, but not required: human resources, career counseling, domestic violence, sexual assault, case management, mental health, substance abuse, homelessness, legal/criminal justice system, poverty, or the child welfare system.

DCFS background check required as well as ability to comply as a mandated reporter, and have access to reliable transportation.
