This WALK-IN workshop can help you find where to start and if you're eligible* for sealing/expungement; get a copy of your criminal record; answer your general questions; and be referred to free legal aid. This is a FREE workshop, but there are costs related to the expungement/sealing process. Please bring a valid state ID or drivers license.

Offenses **NOT eligible for sealing/expungement include DUIs and reckless driving, animal crimes, sex offenses (exceptions are prostitution and misdemeanor public indecency), and domestic battery and violations of orders of protection.*

If you have already obtained a copy of your record from the Illinois State Police, please drop it off at YWCA McLean County, 1201 North Hershey, Bloomington or send to ywmi2@ywcamclean.org by Tuesday, August 7 to be eligible for a free legal consult the day of the workshop.
