RESPONSIBILITIES

This position is responsible for supervising school-age children in a before- and after-school setting. Teachers must work as a team with the assistant teachers and site coordinators to create and implement lesson plans and activities, and communicate with parents. This person will need to be knowledgeable of DCFS regulations.

 - 1560 clock hours of experience in a recreational program or licensed day care center serving school-age children or license exempt school-age child care program operated by a public or private school and either 6 semester hours of credit from an accredited college or university related to school-age child care, child development, elementary education, physical education, recreation, camping or other related fields.
 - Or**
 - A high school diploma or equivalency certificate plus 3120 clock hours of experience in a recreational program, kindergarten, or licensed day care center serving school-age children or a license exempt school-age child care program operated by a public or private school.
- Must have a Bachelor's degree, and at least six hours of child development
- Experience teaching children preferred.
- Excellent communication and classroom management skills.
- Work and/or attend YWCA events during evening and weekend hours.
