YWCA Stepping Stones

Become a volunteer advocate for survivors of sexual assault. You can be there for someone in crisis, either directly or indirectly, by being a trained volunteer support person at YWCA Stepping Stones. Training is free. Forty hours are required for all volunteers. **Training will be virtual.**

TRAINING IS FEBRUARY 2-23

Attend virtually three days a week throughout February:
Tuesday/Thursday 5:30-9:30 p.m. | Saturday 1:00-5:00 p.m.

After completing the 40-hour training, volunteers are qualified to help:

- Take hotline calls
- Provide in-person medical advocacy
- Provide in-person/virtual prevention education for McLean County schools, businesses, or groups
- Provide support at public events
- Complete data entry and other office work
- Translating materials and interpret during counseling and advocacy sessions (bi-lingual volunteers needed!)
